Insurance Update:

We have had one bid at \$1500 for directors insurance and are waiting on two other bids. The Airport Authority has contacted us regarding insurance. We will meet with them in the next few weeks. Practice at the track remains the same. The insurance situation for non-supervised practice is identical to that of last year. That is there is no insurance except on race days through IKF.

2004 Race schedule:

X-Karts are interested in doing a race in Reno. Details will be forthcoming.

Rules of the Road:

By-Laws:

Proposed that we extend the review period for the by-laws as substantial work is required. Some of our by-laws conflicts Nevada law. Mark suggested we seek professional advice to review. Motion - Passed

New Items:

Boat, Sport and RV Show:

Mike explained that this year the cost of the show is only the power - \$65. We have a position close to the entrance of the show. This year the boat show is sold out. We have two people working every time slot for booth. Passes will be at will-call. Do your time then return the pass. Set-up is Wednesday

Track account funding:

Bob proposed to direct 15% from membership fees to track account. Motion, Richard, second Brian Ellison, approved

Survey results:

So far we have received 39 surveys to date. Another 10 or so arrived tonight. Will compile and publish the results in the newsletter and website.

Non-member practice changes:

Season Pass Proposal:

Graeme outlined a Season Pass concept to allow people to pay for all races up front. In return for doing so they will get a discount of approximately 18%. Motion: Rick Schull, second Greg Zink, passed. Graeme will need to modify for TU + 10 Races and will send to all members.

Gary outlined a proposal to allow the three kart shops complimentary signage at the track. Picking the spots at the track would be based on tenure. Motion: Passed.

Classes and Race Format proposals:

After lengthy discussion of formats and class combinations Glenn McKinnon made a motion to accept last year's race format and classes with the laps at 8-10-8 for the three heats. Passed. Rick Graves suggested an alternative proposal of two longer heats and grid based off championship point standings rather than qualifying.

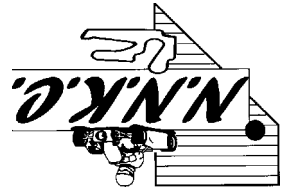
